Thirteen members and their guests attended the April 10, 2002 meeting to hear Mr. Bill Meade of The Boeing Company present information on the "Comparison Of The Inspection Reliability Of Single Wall Vs. Double Wall Techniques For Inconel Weldments". Current Boeing and industry standards mandate the use of single-wall radiographic exposures for such part for welded ducts greater than 3.5 inches in diameter. In late 1999, Boeing Manufacturing Research & Development (MR&D) initiated a Probability of Detection (POD) study to investigate the potential of using of double-wall radiographic exposures for welded ducts greater than 3.5" in diameter in an effort to reduce cycle time and film usage. The presentation discussed the results to date of that study. Lynn Graham won the \$30.00 door prize and Bill Meade won the free dinner.
