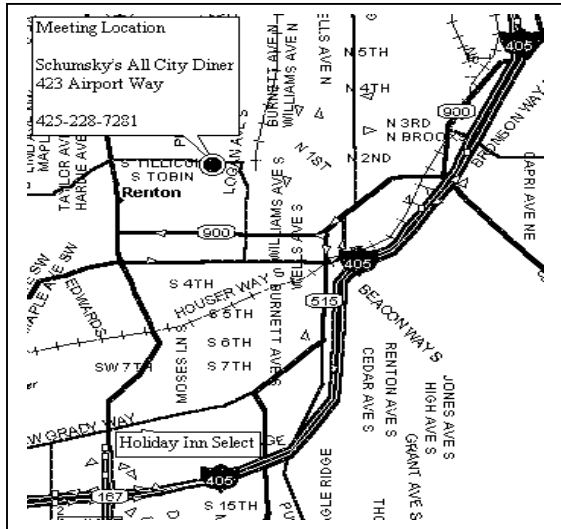

PAST EVENTS—January Meeting

The meeting was conducted at Schumsky's All City Diner in Renton. Mr Ricky Morgan, SOC director gave a presentation updating the activities of ASNT and findings post Northridge earthquake. A dinner of salmon or roast pork with scalloped potatoes, baked beans w/bacon, garden vegetable salad, and delectable cookies preceded Mr. Morgan's presentations.

Hopefully all members signed the guest book for the year-end cash drawing. As another meeting incentive corporate member Caliber Inspection generously offered to pay dinner costs for any of they're employees who attend a section meeting. The thirty-dollar door prize is being contributed to an accumulative pot that has the name of section attendees at each meeting entered. So the more meetings you attend the better your chances are at winning the pot at the end of the year.
