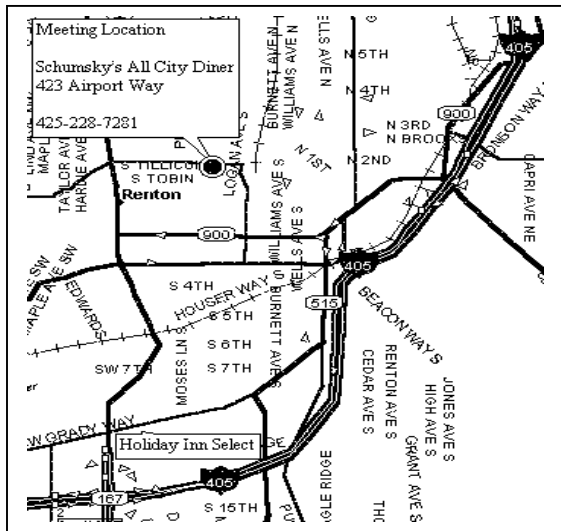

Laboratories gave a presentation on Flexible Ultrasonic Arrays. A dinner of chicken or roast pork with scalloped potatoes, baked beans w/bacon, garden vegetable salad, and delectable cookies preceded the presentation.

Hopefully all members signed the guest book for the year-end cash drawing. As another meeting incentive corporate member Caliber Inspection generously offered to pay dinner costs for any of they're employees who attend a section meeting. The thirty-dollar door prize is being contributed to an accumulative pot that has the name of section attendees at each meeting entered.
